  - a) Site Plan Review 44 Bridge Street Lakefield Notice of Site Plan

Angela Chittick presented the site plan for 44 Bridge Street to the Committee which is zoned commercial but currently used residential. The residential building is being converted into a flower shop and garden centre and will have a new entrance off of Clementi Street. The existing entrance off of Queen Street will be used for deliveries only.

The Committee reviewed the layout of the new parking lot which has 12 parking spaces proposed, two of which are accessible (one being Type A and the other Type B). Ms. Chittick stated that the exterior of the business has heritage designation but the interior of the building does not. The building must be brought up to date to the current building code which includes accessible doorways and washrooms.

The Chair suggested that at the intersection of Clementi Street and Bridge Street, an audible signal crossing be installed as three of the four corners are now commercial which increases foot traffic in the area.

That the Committee recommends to the Peterborough County Transportation Master Plan Committee that the intersection of Clementi Street and Bridge Street in Lakefield be updated to include an audible signal crossing.
