That the tender for the Community Risk Assessment to be conducted in 2023 be awarded to The Loomex Group at a cost of \$12,950 (HST excluded) and that this be included in the draft operations budget; and

That the Treasurer include the projects and supporting funding included therein as part of the Consolidated 2023 Taxation Budget document to be presented on January 26, 2023.
