**1. Opening Ceremonies**

Lakeshore Capacity Study (Lovesick Lake) – Selwyn Mayor Sherry Senis advised that Selwyn Township and Trent Lakes received a delegation from the Lovesick Lake Association and Committee for the Preservation of Lovesick Lake pertaining to a Lakeshore Capacity Study for Lovesick Lake. Councils had a general discussion regarding Lovesick Lake. Mayor Senis noted that Selwyn would be sending correspondence to Trent Lakes, North Kawartha, Peterborough County, TSW/Parks Canada and Treaty 20 First Nations to determine interest in pursuing a Terms of Reference for a Lakeshore Capacity Study for Lovesick Lake.
